I, Stephan J. Szyszkoski, in a field survey on G10 06/12/2012
G11 06/19/2012 do hereby state
that, under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2
above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey
instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of
a Court of Law and /or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with
the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established,
re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded
on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(G10) Quarter corner common to Sections 27 and 28. 1848 - Established by Wells Burt, Deputy
Surveyor, midway and on the Section line between Section corners 40.00 chains north and south. Set
Cedar post. Cedar 14" N73E 9 links, Y.Birch 14" N47W 96 links. Found no subsequent record.

(G11) Section corner common to Sections 27-28-33-34. 1848 - Established by Wells Burt, Deputy
Surveyor. Set Cedar post. Hemlock 10" N31E 28 links, Cedar 16" S60W 10 links. Found no subsequent
record.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(G10) The original post and accessories were not recovered. Monumented corners were recovered at G13
(reestablished in 1968) and G9 (perpetuated original corner position). The observed distance between
these two is 10436.59 feet (GLO record 10560 feet), 123.41' shorter than the original record. At
7902.64' (GLO=7920) north of G13, I found the remains of an old post, down and rotting, approx. 3 ft.
east of an old and down N-S barbed wire fence (wire on ground and of various ages), with two trees, a
Balsam and a Poplar, not of record, having overgrown upper and lower blazes facing it. The position
of this post fits with a stream crossing 2230' south (GLO = 2211') and with the GLO record
measurements to the north and south shorelines of Harris Lake, south of G11. I conclude that the
majority of the discrepancy with the GLO record between G13 and G9 properly belongs in the section
line north of this corner and I accept the position of the post as the best available evidence of the
position of the original corner. Drove a monument into the old post hole.

(G11) The original post and accessories were not recovered. Found no acceptable evidence of the
position of the original corner on the ground. Reestablished the position for the corner by double
proportionate measurement between monumented corners G13 5268.43' South (GLO 5280'), E11 5290.41'
West (GLO 5280'), J11 7936.28' East (GLO 7920.66'), and G10 2634.21' North (GLO 2640'). From the
position thus established, I found the north and south shorelines of Harris Lake fitting very well
with the GLO record (north shore 106'M vs. 112' GLO; and south shore 671'M vs. 686' GLO), as well as
the stream crossing noted in the record as 6.5 chs. north of G11.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

(G10) Set 1"IDx32" I.pipe with 4" alum. MDNR cap
in hole left by old post.
Set measuring nail with MDNR tag in the side of:
9" Maple N56E 8.05' mrkd "1/4S NBT"
10" W.Spruce S52E 42.1' do
9" Maple S27E 45.9' do
8" Maple in clump S19W 20.5' do
Set sq'd Cedar post adjacent.
Bearings are magnetic.

(G11) Set 1"IDx32" I.pipe with 4" alum. MDNR cap.
Set measuring nail with MDNR tag in the side of:
10" Maple N33E 21.4' mrkd "S27 NBT"
12" W.Birch S28E 17.0' "S34 NBT"
16" R.Pine S04W 12.6' "S33 NBT"
6" Maple in clump N65W 20.9' "S28 NBT"
Set sq'd Cedar post adjacent.
Bearings are magnetic.
