I, Stephan J. Szyszkoski, in a field survey on F11 05/12/2012 do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and /or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(G9) Corner common to Sections 21-22-27-28. 1846 Established by Deputy Surveyors Hubbard and Ives. Monument not noted but was almost certainly a wood post. Maple 12" S51W 14 links, Maple 6" N75E 11 links. 1939 - Norman T. Thompson RLS ran and marked the south line of Section 21 and states about G9 "No BT old [unreadable] and corner of fence. Set hem. post. Fence running N & W." No NBTs noted in the 1939 notes.

(F11) Quarter corner common to Sections 28 and 33. 1846 - Established by Deputy Surveyors Hubbard and Ives. Set post. Hemlock 14" N26E 19 links, Hemlock 22" S29W 17 links. Found no subsequent record.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(G9) The original post and accessories were not recovered. Found the nearly obliterated remains of old barbed wire fencing running N & W, unmaintained and in the ground. Reestablished the position of the 1939 post, which was not recovered, at the intersection of the fences. Found distances to adjacent corners as follows: North 5221.02' (5280' GLO), South 5255.16' (5280' GLO), West 5306.04' (5311.7' GLO), and East approx. 5286' to a found 3/4" pipe and a 4' length of 5/8" rebar in a small mound of rocks (5278.7' GLO). Accepted the fence intersection as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner and drove a monument at that position.

(F11) The original post and accessories were not recovered. Found no acceptable evidence of the position of the original corner on the ground. Reestablished the position for the corner midway and on the Section line between Section corners 2648.12' east and west, being proportionate to the original record.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

(G9) Set 1"IDx32" I.pipe with 4" alum. MDNR cap. Set measuring nail with MDNR tag in the side of:  
10" Hemlock N42E 14.35' mrkd "S22 NBT"  
12" Hemlock S20E 34.7' "S27 NBT"  
3" Maple S21W 4.55' "S28 NBT"  
14" Hemlock N64W 38.6' "S21 NBT"  
Set sq'd Cedar post adjacent.  
Bearings are magnetic.

(F11) Set 1"IDx32" I.pipe with 4" alum. MDNR cap. Set measuring nail with MDNR tag in the side of:  
7" Sugar N12E 6.2' mrkd "1/4S NBT"  
5" Hemlock S89E 17.15' do  
5" Y.Birch N56W 10.7' do  
9" Maple N30W 24.75' do  
Set sq'd Cedar post adjacent.  
Bearings are magnetic.
