A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration: 1848: Original Survey by James H. Mullett - B.T.'s - Aspen, 6" - N41°E - 62 lks.; Aspen, 12" - S84°E - 85 lks. All original evidence for this corner has been destroyed by ice shoves and shore line crosion. B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner: We re-established this corner by projecting a line between corners G-5 and F-5 West to the river. The distance from Corner F-5 (S1/4 Corner of Section 9) to the Meander Corner is 232.2 feet compared to 2.0 Chains (132 feet) GLO record. The terrain drops sharply to a low swampy area which may have been flooded at the time of the original survey.
