(W-W 1/64) West-West One-Sixty-Fourth corner of Section 4. Not set in original survey, no evidence of subsequent establishment.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(C-W-SW 1/64) Corner position established mid-point and on-line between the Southwest One-Sixteenth corner and the South One-Sixteenth corner on the West line of Section 4.

(W-W 1/64) Corner position established mid-point and on-line between the West One-Sixteenth corner on the South line and the Southwest corner of Section 4.
