- A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

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- Plat of Survey by Robert Goodreau, RLS No. 43053, shows this corner with the following ties: 10" Pine S640E 79.65; 1999: 8" Cedar - S36°W - 53.35'; 10" Maple - N44°W - 86.53'; Iron Pin w/cap - North - 81.0'.
- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

We found a P.K. Nail with brass washer in line with the centerline of a county road projected from the west and on line between the NE Corner and the NW Corner of Section 35, T36N-R28W. We also found 4 ties in location as described in part "A" above. This position fits reasonably well with measurements to corners 1/2 mile North and 1/2 mile South, and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.
