A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

C-1 – NW section corner, section 5, T29N,R03E

1960 – Department of Conservation Land Corner Record –

Kenneth J. Ostling, P.S.#10068 – This corner was restored at record government measure from standard corner to Sections 31 and 32, T30N, R03E, by Forestry Division survey crew while making a survey in this area. Stumps in general area for possible government BT's, but they do not conform very well with government record. Unable to locate anything more conclusive. Corner to sections 31 and 32, T30N,R03E is 10 links west.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applies in restoring or re-establishing corner:

C-1 – NW section corner, section 5, T29N,R03E

Found Department of Conservation monument per 1960 Land Corner Record by Ostling. Accepted found D.O.C. monument as a careful and faithful reestablishment of the position of the original corner. Found no other evidence to dispute the location for the corner.

4"dia. stamped alum. cap on 1" galvanized pipe.
