

Randolph Hepworth</u> a field survey on <u>Yay 2, 2000</u> do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and /or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner.

I found a 1 1/2" x 17" Pipe inside a monument box, 1.6' South of the centerline of E-W highway. Old occupation lines run to North and to South. At 20" deep, I found a 5/8" Iron as described by MDSH, 1970.
