I found a 3/4" ell-shaped Iron as described by Barnett, LCRC 100129. I believe that this corner originates with Terrill, Kistler & Anderson (TKA), circa 1971. I have searched diligently in the past for ancient corner evidence and have never been able to find any. This iron falls 3 feet west of an ancient woven wire and steel fence post fence running N-S. All LCRC 100129 witnesses are standing and measure OK. This Iron is the only corner evidence existing and is the only corner known to be of recent historical use in the surrounding plats and unplatted land.

I accept the ell-shaped Iron as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner. No evidence is known to me that would lead me to believe the corner should be at another location.
