B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applies in restoring or re-establishing corner:

F-11 Revisited corner during traverse around section 28 and found monument to be gone. Area had seemed to be disturbed. Blue Carsonite post was destroyed and hole dug where monument was previously set. Reset new monument off of witnesses per DNR surveys. Accepted corner as a careful and faithful reestablishment of the position of the original corner.

G-11 Found stamped 4" aluminum DOC monument per K.J. Ostling survey. Found fence going south and east from corner. Found no other evidence to dispute the location for the corner. Accepted found DOC monument as the best available evidence for the position of the original corner.
