

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

No original evidence was found. A gravel County Road runs North and South from the corner position. At the corner position I found a 1"X3 foot bolt below the gravel. A fence runs West from a point 30 feet South of the corner position. A local resident, Roy Paajanen, age 72, testified his father installed this fence and it was set South of the Section Line to accommodate a road running West which was used 50 plus years ago but is now covered with trees.

At the corner position I set a 5/8"X24" rebar with a $3\frac{1}{4}$ " stamped cap 4" below top of gravel. I established a reference monument, a $2\frac{1}{2}$ "X30" aluminum pipe with a $3\frac{1}{4}$ " cap stamped to read: County Remonumentation, T48N R40W, S16, S17, S20, S21, 1996, P.S. 17610. I also established three other bearing objects.
