Corner established by J. Wells Burt, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, May 1851. Set Wood Post.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

At the apparent corner position I found a 1" iron pin in a monument box in the pavement on Highway M-28. This corner has been in since at least 1963. It is at the intersection of two major roads. The corner position is in general agreement with the original GLO field notes. This 1" iron pin has been used for numerous surveys in the area. I accepted the position as being the only logical position.

Research is on file with County Remonumentation Representative.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

At the corner position is a 1" iron pin in a monument box in the pavement of Highway M-28. I set two reference monuments which are 2 1/2" X 30" aluminum pipe with a 3 1/4" cap stamped to read: County Remonumentation, RM, S23, S24 S25, S26, T48N R40W, 1996, P.S. 17610. In addition to the reference monuments I established two other reference objects.
