

No original evidence was found. I found a 4"X4" metal yellow tag 18 feet North of the position I set the corner. The tag was scribed 4 feet South to approximate corner. I re-established the corner by single proportionate measure and on the Town line between the monumented SW Corner of Section 31, and the St Corner of Section 32. These two corners had been monumented from original bearing trees in 1961 and 1970 respectively.
