

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

No original evidence was found. Apparent corner position is in a road which has been in existence since the 1920's. A split of the section places the corner 7.5 feet West of a well maintained fence line running North and South. These fence lines are occupied lines of 4 different owners. I re-established the corner in the center-line of the road and on line with the fences running North and South.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

At the corner position I set a 5/8"X12" rebar with a 3" stamped cap 2" below top of blacktop. The cap is stamped to read: County Remonumentation, T48N R41W, 1, S23, S26, 1998, P.S. 17610. I established a reference monument, a $2\frac{1}{2}$ "X30" split base aluminum pipe with a 3" cap stamped to read the same as above. I also established 3 other reference objects.
