- Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:
 - On August 10, 1848, Austin Burt set a cedar post from which an 8" cedar bears N23°E, 19 links and an 8" W. birch N19°W,
 - Corner is marked by an iron pin set by E. Applekamp Date unknown.
- Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

I found the 1/2" iron pin with a cap RLS 17610 as noted above and accepted it as being in the correct location as it lies in harmony with local residences and has been used in several surveys of record.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

I set a 2 1/2" diameter x 30" long aluminum pipe with a 3 1/4" diameter aluminum cap stamped: County Remonumentation; T48N; R42W; M.C.; S-18; S-17; 1995; RLS 28410, from which I established the following bearing trees and/or reference objects:

10" cedar - N50°E - 18.39 feet 6" cedar - S54°E - 18.25 feet 10" hemlock - S19°W - 10.85 feet 6 foot steel rail with sign - S76°W - 1.41 feet
