

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

I found no remains of the original corner or accessories. The course of the river has changed dramatically since 1845 and the area of the Meander Corner is now subject to seasonal flooding. I re-established a position for the Meander Corner by single proportionate measurement. The corner now falls 110' South of the present right bank of the Ontonagon River.
