I, Stephan J. Szyszkoski, in a field survey on C6 08/22/2012 do hereby state
that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2
above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey
instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of
a Court of Law and /or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with
the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established,
re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded
on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(C6) Quarter corner common to Sections 17-18. 1980 - K.L.Sackett RLS found and accepted an old cedar
post. Set 1"IDx36" I.pipe with 4" alum. cap. 6" Cedar S22W 7.8', 4" Cedar N55W 12.3', 5" Cedar N86E
9.8'. 2003 - 1980 monument recovered in good condition and re-witnessed by the undersigned: 6" Cedar
N47E 15.5', 8" Cedar S67E 34.6', 5" Aspen S18E 11.9', 6" Aspen N81W 15.3'. Squared cedars 1.5' W'ly
and 1.5' S'ly.

(MC N. of C5) Meander corner on the shore of Lake Superior between Sections 7 and 8. 1980 -
K.L.Sackett RLS established a Witness Corner to the original Meander Corner, which is shown on the
original plat as being 16.50 chains north of Section corner C5. Set 1"IDx36" I.pipe with 4" alum.
cap. 9" Spruce S05W 5.9', 6" Spruce S78E 24.9'.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(C6) Found the 1980 monument in good condition and at record bearing and distance from the 2003
witnesses, which were remeasured as described below.

(MC N. of C5) Found the 1980 monument in good condition and at record bearing and distance from the
remaining 1980 accessory, described below. The monument was found to be 1060.59' north of Section
corner C5, making its position 28.41' south of the original M.C. position. Accepted the monument as
a careful and faithful reestablishment of the position of the original corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

(C6) Found 1"ID I.pipe with 4" alum. MDNR cap.
Fd. measuring nail with MDNR tag in the side of:
6" Cedar N46E 15.7' scribing plain
8" Cedar S68E 34.6' do
9" Poplar S18E 11.75' overgrown blazes
8" Poplar N79W 15.0' do
Bearings are magnetic.

(MC) Found 1"ID I.pipe with 4" alum. MDNR cap
for a WITNESS CORNER - the cap is stamped
"Meander cor."
Set measuring nail with MDNR tag in the side of:
11" Spruce S07W 6.15' old blazes 1980 NBT
9" W.Birch S80W 14.3' mrkd "MC NBT"
4" Balsam N60E 3.25' do
8" W.Birch S80E 17.05' do
Set sq'd cedar post adjacent.
Bearings are magnetic.
