A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

James Wampler set a wood post in 1822 as the original government corner. It is a common corner to four (4) townships per the original field notes. Reference corners: M-1 of T8N-R14E, M-13 of T9N-R14E and A-13 of T9N-R15E. L. Davis of S.C.C.R.C. in survey dated 1928 reported a cross on top of a large stone. Charles Alloway P.S. recovered and recorded an I-bolt May 1971, L.C.R.C. Liber 3, page 41. Clyde McDaniel P.S. found no evidence of previous corner and set a 4" rerod from previous witnesses, L.C.R.C. Liber 7, page 42. Old County Surveyors Record shows no record of corner.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Found a surveys cap #15405 on a 4" rerod on approximate centerline of existing gravel roads. Verified corner from previously recorded witnesses. The previously reported railroad spike 1.78' west of corner was actually a 1 4" iron bar, which was replaced this day with a cap #24608 on a 4" rerod. Referenced J. Milletics survey Liber 6, page 438 and listed dimensions appear to be taken from the REMONUMENTATION 1 4" iron bar.
