A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration: L3 N½ Corner Section 12, T41N - R 16 W Sept. 10, 1845 - John Burt D.S. set qr. section post referenced by: Tamarack 5 North 25 Tamarack 6 N 60 E 23
April 12, 1995 - LCRC (L.4 Pg. 176) by Gerald W. Carlson P.S. 24589 indicates "Found a 3/4" iron 1.3' below ground at intersection of Bear and Alger streets. Found references as indicated on an LCRC by G. Carlson in 1989."
B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:
L3 Dec. 3, 1998 - Thomas P. O'Brien P.S. recovered a 3/4" solid iron rod. Existing B.T.'s verify corner location as found by Carlson April 12, 1995. Replaced iron rod with Schoolcraft County Monument stamped to identify.
C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner. L3 Schoolcraft County Monument stamped to identify. Made measurements to the following references:
