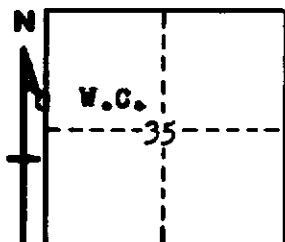

DESCRIPTION OF CORNER Witness Corner for 1/4 Corner between 34/35

CORNER MONUMENT 1" Iron Pipe with 4" Aluminum Cap

DATE MONUMENT PLACED AND WITNESSED 10/24/63 by A.O. Enger, 5/18/65, recorded and monumented
by Bray and Hinds

DESCRIPTION IN DETAIL AS TO HOW CORNER WAS LOCATED AND IDENTIFIED OR RESTORED.

This Corner was found 11/3/60 by A.O. Enger, stumps of two Original BT's. ~~BT~~
Yellow Pine, 10", N 63° E, 26 Dcs. uprooted lying on River bank with axe marks
visible. A Yellow Pine 18", N 37° W, 58 Dcs., badly rotted with axe marks and
overgrowth. 1/4 Corner for 34/35 lies in stream 48 Dcs. south of Witness Corner.
