- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:
- (M1) Recovered the 1956 monument as described, in good condition, and at record bearing and distance from the two W. Pine stub witnesses. Left the monument in place and marked four new bearing trees as described below. This corner is being recorded in order to update the accessories.
- (M2) Driginal post and accessories not recovered. Found no acceptable evidence of the position of the original corner on the ground. Reestablished the corner on a straight line between Section corner 2664.55 ft. south and township corner 2615.93 ft. north, being proportionate to the original record. At the position for the corner, I placed a 1"IDx36" iron pipe capped with a 4" dia. cast aluminum MDNR tablet appropriately stamped. I found a 1/2" re-rod nearby, apparently placed by an adjacent landowner. It's position is noted below.
