Post placed by J.D. Mullett, 1823, 8 55 1/2 W 2.6 ch (171.60') 16" Poplar, N 86 W 2.18 ch (143.88') 9" Poplar, South 5.00 ch (330.00') Swamp edge.

Andrew Huggins, Shiawassee County Surveyor used this position to establish the center of section 25.

Elmer F. Joslin, Shiawassee County Surveyor recovered the Huggins monuments and divided the S 1/2 of

- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:
- M-10 Standard East 1/4 Corner of Section 25, T5N-R4E.

Extensive investigation indicates the original and subsequent monuments are obliterated. A RE-construction of the Huggins and Joslin surveys indicates a position midway between the standard section corners and in line with a 50/60 year old fence west on the 1/4 line.

The longitudinal position is determined by doubling the distance from the Huggins/ Joslin center of section and a fence intersection at the E 1/16 on E-W 1/4 line. This position places less than a 6 minute deflection in the range line along the east side of section 25 and is compatible with the range line (East line) of sections 24 and 36.

Surveys in Section 30, T5N,R4E Genesee County, have not located or established a position for this standard corner or the closing west 1/4 corner of section 30.

These surveys appear to have utilized a relatively recent fence line (20/30 years old) running northerly from Braden Road to the Shiawassee River. If extended, this fence would fall 26' east of this position.

A fence of similar age (20-30 years) running south from the N.E. corner of Sec. 25 ends near the 1/4 mile, but if extended southerly would fall approximately  $60^\circ$  west of this position.

It appears that land owners have not had benefit of a survey defining the range line (county line) and have taken magnetic direction for construction of fences of convenience in the area.

This position was reviewed and accepted by the Shiawassee County Remon. peer group on 19 March 1996
