B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Original monument and accessories have been obliterated. Found 1/2" pipe as referenced in no.'s 2, 3 and 4 above. I found no conflicting evidence and accepted this location as the best available evidence of the original corner position. Excavation for Harrison marker provided no further evidence.
