A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

United States Government Survey, 1815 Instructions, Surveyed 1825, Bearing Trees B. Oak 7" \$2-1/2deg E 23 Links(15.18)

B. Oak 16" N25deg W 80 Links(52.80) Meas. (N) 40 Chains(2640) (E) 39.5 Chains(2607)

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Found a 3/4"(OD)-1/2"(ID)x6" from Pipe at East edge of gravel surface on Mester Road. Set straddle witnesses and removed this iron. Found a 3/8"x17" Iron Rod. Removed Iron Rod and Found a 1-1/2"(OD)-1"(ID) Iron Pipe 10" below gravel surface. Straddle witnesses indicate this iron to be 0.10 West. In 1941, W.J. Armstrong found the remains of a wood stake but was unsure of it as being the correct location for this point. The Iron Pipe, last found, seems to be typical of Mr. Armstrong although no bricks or stones are in evidence. Many surveys have been tied to this point as it exists. Could not remove this Iron Pipe. Could not set standard Remonumentation Cap on top. Set a 3/4" Iron Pipe with a RT, 3" Bolt and Plastic Cap stamped CCW #13604 on top, 4" below gravel surface.


