A timber sale contract for this scaled, sealed bid timber sale will be awarded to the responsible bidder offering the highest sealed bid price. All units of volume listed below were estimated using the Inventory Manager computer program and the new Michigan taper model. #### **BOND AND PAYMENT SCHEDULE:**

- 1. A bond in the amount of \$1,000.00 to insure faithful performance of the conditions of the contract will be deposited by the successful bidder within 21 days of the sale award.
- 2. Cutting in any sale or unit without the required advance payment would be considered a trespass.
- 3. Total payment must be paid in advance or according to the following schedule:
  - (a) Ten percent (10%) of the sale value must be paid within 21 days of the sale award.
  - (b) The 10% down payment will be credited towards the first unit cut.
  - (c) Payment for each of the following units must be made before cutting begins in that unit:

- 4. If no cutting takes place, the 10% down payment will not be refunded.
- 5. Operations on the contract issued will terminate on 12/31/2027.

#### SALE STATISTICS

Volumes were calculated in cubic feet using the Michigan taper model. Cubic foot volume includes all wood inside bark for the product indicated. For display purposes, cubic feet were converted to cords and MBF using a simple conversion factor, e.g. 79 cubic feet per cord and 185 cubic feet per MBF. The cubic foot volumes are precise; the cords and MBF volumes are not. Cubic foot volume cannot be directly converted to cords or boards with precision.

## Sale Specific Conditions & Requirements

#### 1 - Sale Area

#### 1.2 - Boundaries

#### 1.2.1 - Painted Boundaries (9/19)

The sale boundary and Payment Unit boundaries are marked and identified by red paint. Also, Berry Creek road serves as a sale boundary and payment unit boundary. Exterior sale boundary lines against state are marked with red paint. The painted boundary line trees are not Included Timber and are to be protected.

#### 2 - Timber Specifications

#### 2.1 - Included Timber

#### 2.1.4 - Designated Timber Unit(s) (6/17)

Within Payment Unit(s) 1 and 2, all damaged trees that received 40% or greater crown damage from recent ice storm are designated for cutting, this includes standing stem and any tops on ground. Trees that received no damage will be protected during timber harvest.

### 2.1.11 - Description of Timber Note (2/04)

Note that this is an ice storm salvage sale. All payment units will be scaled by the DNR Sale Administrator. Chipping of Sale area will not be required but is encouraged. If sale is chipped, the Purchaser must provide electronic confirmation of scale tickets at minimum of twice per week. To convert red pine chip weight to cords, we will use a conversion of 1 cord = 1.9 tons or 1 cord = 3,800 pounds. This is from the USDA's Timber Management Field Book, 2008 Edition table 2.10 Weight Table for Various Woods.

#### 3 - Payments

#### 3.2 - Scaled Sales

### 3.2.1 - Scale Location (2/04)

Forest products will be placed for measurement at designated landing locations for scaling. In addition, negotiate with the Sale Administrator to determine the frequency of the scaling.

#### 3.4 - Damaged Timber

#### 3.4.3 - Special Protection Areas (8/11)

The Purchaser shall protect special protection areas from damage by the Purchaser's operations. Special protection areas are the riparian management zones. If the Purchaser's operations have resulted in erosion into open water through carelessness, the Purchaser shall pay \$250.00 as fixed, agreed and liquidated damages for each day or part thereof until the issue is resolved.

## 4 - Transportation

#### 4.1 - Construction

#### 4.1.3 - Slash and Earthen Piles (8/04)

Piles or windrows of earth along roads and landings that have been widened or constructed shall be leveled. Slash from road maintenance or construction, including stumps, shall be dispersed throughout the sale unless other utilized or directed by the Sale Administrator.

#### 4.1.8 - Road Work (1) (8/07)

Road opening may be required to access any Payment Unit. The wood removed for road opening may be utilized by the producer for contract price (or current market value of not on contract) and will be scaled by the Sale Administrator.

#### 4.2 - Maintenance

#### 4.2.5 - Two Wheel Drive Condition (2/04)

All existing trail roads on and adjacent to the Sale Area must be passable by two-wheel drive traffic for the duration of the sale.

#### 5 - Operations

### 5.2 - Conduct of Operations

#### 5.2.1 - Slash

#### 5.2.1.8 - Slash Height (12/08)

No slash or tree tops may exceed 24 inches in height.

#### 5.4 - Soil Protection

#### 5.4.1 - Rutting Restriction, General (7/16)

Operations are to cease immediately if equipment and weather conditions result in rutting of roads and/or skid trails which are 12 inches or greater in depth and 50 feet in length. The Unit Manager or his/her representative may restrict hauling and/or skidding if ruts exceed the specified depth. With the Unit Manager or his/her representative's approval, the Purchaser may return to the area when the risk of rutting has decreased.

#### 5.8 - Protection of Endangered Species

#### 5.8.5 - Protection of Raptor Nests (3/13)

All trees with raptor nests will be protected if found during harvesting operations. Notification will be made to the Unit Manager or his/her representative who will notify the Wildlife Biologist so an onsite evaluation and recommendation can be made, if necessary.

#### 6 - Safety and Fire Prevention

## 6.2 - Signing

### 6.2.1 - Road Posting (10/20)

The Purchaser is responsible for posting and maintaining caution signs on on the haul route prior to beginning operations. The road must be posted at appropriate distances from the Sale Area to warn of logging activity and truck traffic. Signs must be removed when harvest operations are suspended or completed. The Purchaser will provide these signs.

#### 7 - Other Conditions

#### 7.2 - Extensions

#### 7.2.2 - No Extensions (3/09)

There will be no extensions granted on this contract.

#### 7.5 - Loss

## 7.5.1 - Deteriorating Timber (7/09)

The Sale Area has received damage from the ice storm in late March 2025. The Purchaser should harvest the wood as soon as possible. The Department of Natural Resources is held free of responsibility of any further damage or deterioration due to delay in harvesting.
