1. <u>Bid Location, Date, and Time:</u> Bids must be received by the Unit Manager, Traverse City Management Unit, 970 Emerson, Traverse City, MI 49686, no later than 2:00 p.m. on May 14, 2009. For further information concerning this sale, contact the Unit Manager at 231-922-5280.

2. <u>Bidder's Qualifications</u>: Purchaser shall obtain workers compensation insurance to cover claims under Michigan's Worker's Disability Compensation Act of 1969 or similar employee benefit act of any other state applicable to an employee. If all or part of a timber sale was prepared by a private contractor, that contractor and that contractor's company are not permitted to bid on the timber sale contract. Bids will not be accepted from individuals or companies appearing on the DNR/FMFM No-Bid List. This list contains the names of purchasers who previously failed to execute a contract within 21-days or who have a history of poor performance.

3. <u>Preparation of Sealed Bids</u>: Bids shall be manually signed in ink; bid prices must be entered for each species and product in the Bid Price column for all material subject to bidding; and all fill-in blanks must be completed. If erasures or other changes appear on the forms, each erasure or change must be initialed by the person signing the bid.

4. <u>Submission of Sealed Bids</u>: Bid forms may be obtained from the Unit Manager. All bids must be submitted on the bid form and in an <u>envelope clearly identified</u> as described in this section. NOTE: Only one bid form per bid envelope. Sealed bids must be submitted to the Unit office designated in the prospectus and must be submitted at or prior to the time established in the prospectus. The envelope should show on the outside (a) that it is a "Bid for Timber," and (b) the sale name or number, and (c) the date and time of bid opening as shown in the prospectus. Bids received after the time specified in the sale prospectus are late bids and will be rejected.

5. Public Opening of Sealed Bids: If conditions permit, the sealed bids will be publicly opened and posted at the time and place set in the prospectus.

6. <u>Award of Contract</u>: Award of the contract will be made to the Bidder whose bid, conforming to the prospectus, is most advantageous to the State of Michigan on the basis of total value at rates bid for the estimated quantities. The State reserves the right to reject any bid or waive any minor irregularity in bids received. A written award mailed (or otherwise furnished) to the successful Bidder shall be deemed to result in a binding contract without further action by either party.

7. <u>Down Payment:</u> The Bidder to whom award is made must make a down payment within 21 days of the sale award. The amount of the down payment will be calculated as shown in the Bond and Payment Schedule of this prospectus. Only cash may be used to meet this requirement.

8. <u>Performance Security:</u> As guarantee of faithful performance, a cash bond, certificate of deposit, surety bond or irrevocable letter of credit (LOC) is required within 21 days of the sale award. The amount of the performance security is shown in the Bond and Payment Schedule of this prospectus. If an LOC or surety is used, the coverage must extend for at least 6 months beyond the contract expiration.

9. <u>Timber Sale Contract</u>: Additional conditions and requirements common to all timber sales are listed on the timber sale contract (R4031) and are available on line at <u>www.michigan.gov/dnr</u>. Contact the Unit Manager for additional information or a sample contract. Within 21 days of the date of the award letter, the bidder must sign the contract and provide the required down payment, performance security, and verification of worker's disability compensation. The down payment and performance security shall be in accordance with the provisions of the timber sale contract, in the sums stated in this prospectus. If these actions are not taken, then the Bidder, the Bidder's corporation, and the corporation's principals may not be permitted to bid on State timber sales for a period of 1 year. In addition, the Bidder certifies that if awarded this contract, the Bidder will complete the timber sale contract in accordance with its terms and any modifications thereof including requirements to purchase, cut, and remove the included timber by the termination date. 10. Disclaimer of Estimates and Bidder's Warranty of Inspection: Before submitting this bid, the Bidder is advised and cautioned to inspect the sale area, review the requirements of the sale contract, and take other steps as may be reasonably necessary to ascertain the location, estimated volumes, construction estimates, and operating costs of the proposed sale. Failure to do so will not relieve the Bidder from responsibility for completing the contract.

The Bidder warrants that this bid is submitted solely on the basis of the Bidder's examination and inspection of the quality and quantity of the timber offered for sale and the Bidder's opinion of the value thereof and the costs of recovery. No reliance should be placed on the State of Michigan's estimates of timber quality, quantity or costs of recovery. Bidder further acknowledges that the State of Michigan: (i) expressly disclaims any warranty of fitness of timber for any purpose; (ii) offers this timber as is without any warranty of quality (merchantability) or quantity and (iii) expressly disclaims any warranty as to the quantity or quality of timber sold.

11. Certification and Chain-of-Custody: Unless otherwise indicated in the contract under section 7 - Other Conditions of the Sale Specific Conditions & Requirements, the area encompassed by this timber sale is certified to the standards of the Forest Stewardship Council (FSC) - Certificate #SCS-FM/COC-090N and the Sustainable Forestry Initiative (SFI) - Certificate # NSF-SFIS-5Y031-S1. Forest products from this sale may be delivered to the mill as "FSC and / or SFI certified" as long as the contractor hauling the forest products is chain-of-custody (COC) certified or covered under a COC certificate from the destination mill. The purchaser is responsible for maintaining COC after leaving the sale area.

1 - Sale Area

1.2 - Boundaries

1.2.1 - Painted boundaries (6/05)

The sale boundary is marked and identified by red paint.

2 - Timber Specifications

2.1 - Included Timber

2.1.8 - Designated plantation row unit(s) (11/04)

Within Payment Unit(s) 1 and 2, all red pine and aspen trees which meet minimum piece specifications in 2.2 Utilization, within designated plantation rows are designated for cutting. Plantation rows designated for cutting are every third row. Begin with the third row in from the outside of the plantation, then continue every third row. Hardwood trees may be felled only if necessary to facilitate harvest of included timber, and shall be lopped to within three (3') feet of the ground and left in place.

2.2 - Utilization

2.2.6 - Roundwood operation required (6/04)

The skidding of whole trees or tree segments with limbs attached is prohibited. All products must be produced as roundwood and forwarded to existing roads or landing areas in final product length.

4 - Transportation

4.1 - Construction

4.1.3 - Slash and earthen piles (8/04)

Piles or windrows of earth along roads and landings that have been widened or constructed shall be leveled. Slash from road maintenance or construction, including stumps, shall be dispersed throughout the sale.

4.1.7 - Road closure (8/04)

All new roads built into the sale must be blocked to vehicle traffic upon completion of the sale. In general, this will require constructing a four (4') foot high berm constructed of stumps and logs covered with earth. Contact the sale administrator for specific details of design and placement.

5.2.1 - Slash

No slash or tree tops may exceed 24 inches in height.

5.2.3 - Operating Restrictions

5.2.3.1 - Operating restrictions (12/04)

Within Sale Area, unless changed by written agreement, within Payment Unit(s) 1, cutting, skidding, and hauling are not permitted during the period of March 1 to August 31. This restriction is to protect a nearby acitve red-shouldered hawk nest.

5.2.15 - Bark beetle restriction (2/04)

In the event drought creates a high risk of pine bark beetle infestation, pine is not to be cut during the period March 1 through July 1, unless all portions of trees greater than two inches in diameter are removed from the sale area, reduced to chips, or treated to the satisfaction of the Unit Manager or their representative, within fifteen days of being severed from the stump. Pine logs, pulpwood piles and treetop piles for chipping that are decked in the fall or winter within a 1/4 mile of susceptible sites must be removed before March 15. Residual slash must not be placed in piles or rows and must be spread over the site for quick drying. The Department of Natural Resources will exercise this option if the risk of damage warrants.

5.2.38 - No decking against live trees (2/04)

Cut products may not be decked against unmarked or designated leave trees.

5.4 - Soil Protection

5.4.3 - Erosion control (2/04)

Skid trails or haul roads may require erosion control structures or berms per direction of the Unit Manager or their representative.

1.2 - Boundaries

1.2.1 - Painted boundaries (6/05)

The sale boundary and Payment Unit boundaries are marked and identified by blue, red and yellow paint. Exterior sale boundary lines against private property are marked with blue paint. Exterior sale boundary lines against state land are marked with red paint. Interior Payment Unit boundaries along the south side of unit 1 and between units 3 and 5 are marked with yellow paint. A north-south foot trail/open lane separates units 2 & 3 and units 4 & 5, as shown on map. Yellow painted trees designating the interior Payment Unit boundary between units 3 & 5 are only to be cut when both of these Payment Units have been paid. 2.1 - Included Timber

2.1.1 - Clearcut unit(s) with unmerchantable trees (2/04)

Within Payment Unit(s) 2 through 5, cut all trees that are two (2) inches or more in diameter measured at a point of four and one-half (4-1/2) feet above ground level regardless of merchantability.

2.1.4 - Species designation unit(s) (5/07)

Within Payment Unit(s) 1, every third living red pine tree, beginning with the third tree in from the end of each plantation row, is designated for cutting regardless of merchantability.

2.1.11 - Description of timber note (2/04) Note that mixed hardwood pulpwood consists of black cherry, white ash, and sugar maple.

2.2 - Utilization

2.2.2 - Chipping (5/07)

Jack pine trees must be chip harvested to facilitate subsequent planting operations. The purchaser has the option to produce sawlogs or pulpwood bolts, but the remaining portion of the trees must be chipped and hauled to meet silvicultural requirements.

1 - Sale Area

1.2 - Boundaries

1.2.1 - Painted boundaries (6/05)

The sale boundary is marked and identified by red paint and Begold Road on the west side of Payment Unit 1. The interior payment unit boundaries are marked and identified by yellow paint. The reserve areas are marked in blue paint. Do not cut painted boundary line trees.

2 - Timber Specifications

2.1 - Included Timber

2.1.4 - Species designation unit(s) (5/07)

Within Payment Unit(s) 1, 2, 3, and 4 all maple, aspen, cherry, basswood and ironwood trees are designated for cutting regardless of merchantability, EXCEPT those trees marked with green paint. Do not cut any other tree species.

2.1.11 - Description of timber note (2/04) Note that "Mixed Hardwood" = basswood and ironwood.

2.1.12 - Reserve trees (2/04)

The Purchaser shall not cut live or dead reserve trees within cutting units or clearings. Reserve trees are any tree marked with green paint. The Purchaser shall protect reserve trees from damage by the Purchaser's operations. If the Purchaser's operations have cut or damaged reserve trees through carelessness, the Purchaser shall pay \$100 as fixed, agreed and liquidated damages for each reserve tree cut or damaged. Such payment does not constitute ownership of the undesignated timber.

2.1.13 - Reserve areas (6/07)

The Purchaser shall protect reserve areas from damage by the Purchaser's operations. Reserve areas are marked with a blue boundary line and are small areas located in Payment Units 2, 3, and 4. The Purchaser shall not cut live or dead trees within reserve areas nor operate any harvesting equipment within these areas, unless authorized by DNR sale administrator.

2.2 - Utilization

2.2.4 - Skidding length (2/04)

Skidding of unlimbed tops or lengths over 17 feet is not permissible unless approved by the Unit Manager or their representative.

5.2 - Conduct of Operations

Section Name: Sale Specific

5.2.1 - Slash

5.2.1.7 - Slash must be scattered (2/04)

Unless otherwise directed, slash and logging debris shall be uniformly scattered over the sale area and not left in piles or windrows. Slash shall not be allowed to accumulate at the landings. All slash work shall be done concurrently with harvesting.

5.2.1.8 - Slash height (2/04)

No slash or tree tops left on the ground may exceed 36 inches in height.

5.2.2 - Hazard Trees/Snags

5.2.2.1 - Don trees (2/04)

Obvious hollow and/or den trees shall be protected and left standing unless they are a safety hazard.

5.2.4 - Dead and Down Creation

5.2.4.3 - Dead and down creation, dead trees (6/07) Except as provided for in General Condition and Requirement 5.2.2, no dead trees, standing or down, are to be cut, skidded, or processed.

5.2.4.4 - Dead and down creation, grouse (9/05)

To encourage grouse use and other wildlife, in unit(s) 1, 2, 3, and 4 leave a total of 60 trees, 12" diameter or larger log-length (8 foot minimum) piece on the ground. They must be cut at least 4 feet above the ground leaving a snag. These trees should be left standing until all merchantable trees are moved to the landing, at which time they are to be cut, felled and left on the ground next to the snag. These will be evenly scattered throughout the cut unit. This can be an unmerchantable 8 foot or longer piece or a full tree.

5.2.31 - Landing locations (6/08)

Recommended landing areas are marked on the timber sale map with the letter "L". Landings must be confined to these designated sites unless otherwise authorized by the Unit Manager or their representative.

5.2.41 - Snowmobile trail protection (4/07)

Begold road is a snowmobile trail and is shown on the Timber Sale Map. If the trail is used, it must be maintained throughout the sale and restored to a condition equal to or better than before the sale. Do not cut or damage posts with orange trail markers or traffic control signs. Maintain a [20] foot wide slash, debris, and rut free zone daily using the snowmobile trail as the centerline. If the trail is used for hauling, it must be graded to the satisfaction of the Unit Manager or their representative prior to December 1st. The snowmobile trail may not be used for any timber sale operations from December 1 to March 31. No decking of forest products will be permitted along the snowmobile trail. All stumps within 20 feet of the snowmobile trail must be cut at ground level.

1.2 - Boundaries

1.2.1 - Painted boundaries (6/05)

The sale boundary for payment unit 2 is marked and identified by red paint. The boundary for payment unit 1 is marked with red paint on the south and east sides; Walton Road and Hodge Road are the north and west boundaries respectively.

2 - Timber Specifications

2.1 - Included Timber

2.1.1 - Clearcut unit(s) with unmerchantable trees (2/04)

Within Payment Unit(s) 2, cut all jack pine trees that are two (2) inches or more in diameter measured at a point of four and one-half (4-1/2) feet above ground level regardless of merchantability. Do not cut any other species.

2.1.3 - Cut tree marked unit(s) (8/04)
