## **Compartment specific changes made during the Compartment Review**

### **Compartment 024 (Stand Examiner – Darrick Coy)**

Stand 5 & 8 - Add trails protection specs for MCCCT on road.

Stands 53, 54, 55, 58, 59 & 61 - Add snowmobile trail protection specs.

Stand 8 – Extend harvest boundary south to include all terrain favorable for management. Modify regen to 50% aspen/oak.

Stand 7 – Treatment contingent on results of Stand 8. If Stand 8 fails, plant Stand 7 with Stand 8. Adjust start date to reflect contingency.

### **Compartment 027 (Stand Examiner – Doug Tyran)**

Stand 73 – Add clearcut treatment, MUD with an aspen component.

### **Compartment 031 (Stand Examiner – Richard Barber)**

Stand 108 – Remove treatment.

Stand 107 – Add treatment. Include Stand 77 in Compartment 32 to the south.

Stand 60 and all aspen treatments – Drop harvest treatments. Replace with monitoring treatments and delay state date until 2027. Add next steps regarding survival of browse pressure, review across compartment lines for stand feasibility, or continue monitoring for additional time frame.
