Comments were received from Todd McLain with concerns regarding land management. For full comments, contact Land Manager.

Compartment 11 (Stand examiner – Ryan Adamczyk)

Within Stands 6 and 28, leave some oak retention in pockets. Add the Red pine replant tools to the treatment next steps – Roller chop, initial plant, herbicide, and 1 yr. and 3 yr. monitoring treatments.

Add trail protection specs to the treatment in Stand 36.

Compartment 13 (Stand examiner – Cheryl Nelson)

No changes at Compartment Review.

Compartment 15 (Stand Examiner – Ryan Adamczyk)

Stand 36 - change the harvest type to Strip/Patch/Gap Cut (Femelschlag).

Stands 35 and 76 – Add the Red pine restart tools to these treatments – Trench, plant, herbicide, monitoring at 1 yr. and 3 yr.

Add an opening creation treatment to Stand 29. This will be a WLD maintained opening.

Compartment 31 (Stand examiner – Cheryl Nelson)

No changes made at Compartment Review.

Compartment 78 (Stand examiner – Joe Ventimiglia)

Add roller chop and herbicide to Stand 22 next steps and change the management objective to Planted Red Pine. Leave some retention when possible.

Compartment 91 (Stand examiner – Andy Hallfrisch)

No changes made at Compartment Review.

<u>Compartment 100 (Stand examiner – Steve Eisele)</u>

Stands 2 and 9 – Add roller chop, herbicide, 1 yr. and 3 yr. monitoring treatment to the next steps.

Stand 1 and 10 – Add herbicide, 1 yr. and 3 yr. monitoring treatment to the next steps.

Compartment 111 (Stand examiner – Blair Tweedale)

No changes made at Compartment Review.

Compartment 122 (Stand examiner – Steve Eisele)

Stand 25 – Add a selection harvest to this stand if cleared by Mike Walters that it will not affect research areas. May have to delay treatment for several years.

Compartment 127 (Stand examiner – Joe Ventimiglia)

Add a burn treatment in the next steps to Stand 31. The burn will take place south of the angling road to expand the ERA as possible. Burn with Stands 421 and 422.

Drop the opening maintenance treatments on Stands 420 and 424.

No changes at Compartment Review.
