Compartment specific changes made during the Compartment Review:

Compartment 001 (Stand Examiner – Rick McDonald)

- Stand 30 – Check proposed start date on Stand 41 in adjacent Compartment to make sure the start date aligns with Stand 30.

Compartment 004 (Stand Examiner – Rick McDonald)

- Stand 29, 33, 47, 50 and 60– Add trail protection spec's.

Compartment 028 (Stand Examiner – Rick McDonald)

- Stand 66, 108 – Modify prescription to final harvest, capture oak in retention islands.
