Stand 10 Adjust the buffer around the Eastern boulder to tree length. Drop the buffer on the Western boulder.

Stand 234 buffer boulders with elemental occurrences by 320ft and add site condition to 3B. If black throated blue warbler is detected within the stand during field visits, cutting will be restricted from May 16 through August 16. If species is not detected, stand can be treated utilizing normal bark slip specification.
