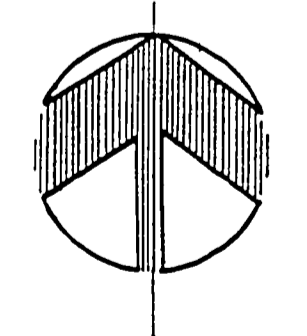


PROJECTS INCLUDE:

- Bituminous or concrete walk from day use picnic shelter to new barrier free fishing pier - Approx. 1140 lf.
- Three barrier free picnic sites along the walk from the shelter to the fishing pier. Sites will include a barrier free picnic table, barrier free firepit/grill, and a walk/pad (bituminous or concrete).
- Chips and fines path in several locations around the existing lagoon - Approx. 3,100 lf.
- Elevated barrier free boardwalk/viewing decks north of the lagoon beach - 2,600 sf.
- Trash receptacles (T). Three from nature center to Tobico Marsh. Three from nature center, around lagoon, to picnic shelter. Six total.
- Recycled plastic bike racks (B). One at each of the following: nature center, fishing pier, picnic shelter. Three total.
- Recycled plastic benches and bench pads (concrete or chips and fines). Twenty benches/pads from the day use picnic shelter, around lagoon, and along the trail to Tobico Marsh. Approx. 1 bench every 200 lf.
