I, Robert L. Jamros, in a field survey on September 25, 1999, 19_____, do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

C2: PLS * George E. Adair, DS, 1851. * Set quarter section post. * W.Pine 12", N.51 E., 23 links. * Y.Pine 10", S.34 W., 27 links. ***** Michigan Department of Conservation, Forestry Division. * Billy D. Buckler, RLS, 1960. * This corner was re-established by single proportionate measure and on line between 2 section corners. * No evidence of original corner. * Set 1" iron pipe with 4" brass cap. * 10 Red Pine, (1/4s NBT) N.46 E., 22 links; * 11" Red Pine, (1/4s NBT) S.30 W., 50 links. * 7" W.Pine, (1/4s NBT) S.84 E., 67 links. * Recorded in Liber 2, Page 161, Alger County Corner Records. ***** No other subsequent restoration of record.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

C2: Located corner search area by calculated position and standard field survey. Found 1" iron pipe with 4" brass cap. Found the references of the 1960 report in good condition and added an additional reference. Corner position as found is accepted as a careful and faithful reestablishment of the position of the original corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

C2: Existing 1" iron pipe with 4" brass cap. * Renewed existing reference trees with BT signs and paint. * Added an additional reference tree with BT signs, blazed, scribed and painted. * Set PK nails with aluminum I.D. washers for measure in the following: Existing - R.Pine 16', N.53 E., 14.80 feet. * Existing - W.Pine 14", S.77 E., 44.45 feet. * R.Pine 24", S.32 W., 33.91 feet. * J.Pine 6", N.35 W., 28.50 feet, "1/4s BT". * Survey marker sign on 6 foot steel post, N.79 E., 1.3 feet. * All bearings are magnetic.
