A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Undated records obtained from Wightman Soored show "Stake " accessory: Oak 6" NW 47.5". Corner recorded under Act 74. PA 1970 by D katekin (PS #8781) in hiber 3. Page 262 as "Yound 1/2" pipe from witness card - accessories: Centerline PVN/ E 31.76". P pole NW 51.66', Centerline 18" square come, block WSW 14.5', NE cor Sec-5 TIN RISW E 125.41"

GII: Post established by U.S. Deputy Surveyor C. Britain in 1831 accessories: hed dak # 813% 15 links and Beech 10 MISE 16 links. Undated records obtained from Wightman Hoored show distance ties to this corner but nothing else.

14: Corner recorded under Act 74. PA 1970 by b. Ratekin (PS #8781) in Liber 1. Page 370 as 'Found 374" holt (bent by grader) - reset on straight line between Southwest and West 174 corners of Section 33 and equal distance - accessories; Centerline Worth South road 8' W. Centerline East West road 12 N. NW cor tel. outlet \$70E 41.90', face Power pule \$70E 63.0', St. sign B60W 20.84', tage 14" W. Oak \$45W 39.91".

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner

E13: Found 1/2" pipe 0.8' below road surface and two (2) of Ratchin's witnesses. Accepted this corner as the best evidence of the original GLO post.

GH: Established corner by protating record County Surveyor distances from corners Ell and GHZ. This protation was accomplished by using undated County Surveyor records obtained from Wightman-Moored. The record distances for the West line, the South line, the Bast-West 1/4 line, and from the South 1/4 to the Center 1/4 of the Section were compared to the measured distances with a mean being formulated. This scale factor was applied to the record distances for the North line and the North 1/2 wile of the East line of the Section. The resulting distances were intersected. This calculated location was found to be only 0.42° West of the projection forth of the accepted South 1/2 of the Bast line of the Section. Also, the provated North 1/2 mile was 0.35° short of the South 1/2 mile for the Bast line of the Section.

14: Found 3/4" built 0.7' below road surface on line with South edge of road going fast and one (1) of katckin's witnesses. Built was found to be midway on line between corners 612 and 613. Accepted this corner.
