above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey
instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of
a Court of Law and /or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with
the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established,
re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(K7) Corner common to Sections 13-14-23-24. 1852 - Established by Z.B.Searles Deputy Surveyor. Set
post. Y.Birch 16" S50W 25 links, Maple 10" N65E 24 links. March 1958 - Liber 2 of LCRC Page 213,
J.P.Smallwood RLS found 3" sq. spruce post. 5" Balsam East 13.00', 14" Maple S40W 4.75', 18" Pine
N55W 22.30'. 1979 - K.L.Sackett RLS found post set by J.P.Smallwood and replaced it with a 1"IDx36"
I.pipe with 4" alum. cap. 18" W.Pine N52W 21.4', 12" Maple S50W 4.8', 8" Balsam S87E 12.4'. Rec.
Liber 1 of LCRC, Page 377.

(15-Sec. 13) West 1/16 corner between Sections 13 and 24. Not established in the original survey.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(K7) Found the 1979 monument in good condition and at record bearing and distance from the NBT Maple
SW, in good condition with overgrown blazes. The NBT W.Pine NW and Balsam SE were not found and
their remains are obscured from view by deep snow. Accepted the monument as the best available
evidence of the position of the original corner.

(15-Sec. 13) Established the corner midway and on the Section line between Section corner 1328.89'
west and Quarter corner 1328.89' east.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

(K7) Found 1"ID I.pipe with 4" alum. MDNR cap.
Set measuring nail with MDNR tag in the side of:
14" Maple S50W 5.3' old blazes 1979 NBT
12" Y.Birch N09E 15.5' mrkd "S13 NBT"
8" twin Sugar S87E 24.4' "S24 NBT"
5" Sugar S23E 13.7' "S24 NBT"
Cear post adjacent.
Bearings are magnetic.

(15) Set 1"IDx32" I.pipe with 4" alum. MDNR cap.
Set measuring nail with MDNR tag in the side of:
3" Tamarack N33E 9.0' mrkd "1/16S BT"
5" B.Spruce S64E 13.0' do
6" B.Spruce S53W 11.45' do
5" B.Spruce N15W 2.2' do
Set sq'd Cedar post adjacent.
Bearings are magnetic.
