I, Stephan J. Szyszkoski, in a field survey on 06/11/14 do hereby state  
that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2  
above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey  
instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of  
a Court of Law and /or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with  
the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established,  
re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded  
on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(F3) Quarter Corner common to Sections 4 and 9. 1975 - The original monument and accessories  
determined to be lost, the corner was reestablished by K.L.Sackett RLS "on line between section  
corners east and west". Set 1"IDx36" iron pipe with 4" aluminum cap. 12" Spruce S38°E 15.8', 8"  
Spruce N34°E 10.9'. Found no subsequent record.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(F3) Found the 1975 monument with only the stem of the aluminum cap remaining in the pipe. The cap  
itself is gone but the monument does not appear to have been disturbed from its original position.  
The 1975 witnesses were not recovered. The monument was found to be 18.2'W and 2.2'S of the  
midpoint position between monumented Section corners. A further investigation showed that G3 and H3  
were also reestablished by Mr. Sackett in 1975, as well as 1/16 corners #1 and #2 of Sec. 9, all in  
effect by single proportionate measurement E-W between E3 and I3. By referring to survey files at  
the MDNR Baraga office, I discovered that the 1975 calculations which produced the corner positions  
to be reestablished contained an error or errors which resulted in corners having been monumented  
thus: F3 is 6.8'W and 0.2'S; G3 is 22.7'E and 4.0'N; H3 is 13.4'E and 1.6'N; and 1/16 cor. #1 of  
Sec.9 is 4.3'W and 1.0'N of the intended position. Since the monuments have been in place for very  
nearly 40 years and have been used to control subsequent surveys in 1978 and 2005, I decided that  
the most prudent course of action was to leave the existing monumented positions undisturbed. I  
accepted the 1975 monumented positions of F3, G3, H3, and 1/16 corner #1 of Sec.9 as controlling for  
the subdivision of Sections 9 and 10. Monumented 1/16 cor. #2 of Sec. 9 was not coordinated in this  
survey.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

(F3) Found 1"ID I.pipe with stem of broken alum. cap  
affixed in the top of the pipe. Set measuring nail  
with MDNR tag in the side of:  
5" Poplar N80°E 8.9' mrkd "1/4S NBT"  
3" Spruce S04°W 10.5' do  
6" Balsam S70°W 7.15' do  
6" Balsam N40°W 7.75' do  
Set sq'd cedar post adjacent.
