I, Stephan J. Szyszkoski, in a field survey on MC 08/30/2011
G2 08/29/2011 do hereby state
that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2
above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey
instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of
a Court of Law and /or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with
the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established,
re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded
on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(MC) Meander corner on the Section line between Sections 4 & 5 at Keweenaw Bay. 1845 - Established
by D.Houghton Deputy Surveyor during the original subdivision of this township, 29.78 chains South of
the Section corner. Found no subsequent record.

(G2) Quarter corner common to Sections 3 and 4. 1986 - Corner position reestablished by
proportionate measurement and monumented by Stephen D. Douglas, U.S. Cadastral Surveyor, in a
dependent resurvey of this township for the Bureau of Land Management. Set 5/8"x36" alum. post,
capped. W.Birch 7" S08E 57.5 links, W.Birch 8" N87W 25 links.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(MC) All evidence of the original post and accessories has been destroyed by road construction.
Found no evidence of subsequent monumentation. Reestablished the corner at record distance
(1965.48') from section corner E1 on a true bearing from E1 of S 00 deg. 24'30"E. This bearing was
determined by Stephen D. Douglas, U.S. Cadastral Surveyor, during the 1985-6 dependent resurvey of
this township "...resulting from an index correction for Deputy Mellons' [sic] survey". The position
for the corner cannot be properly monumented. I established a WITNESS CORNER to the MC 114.37' north
of the MC position on the Section line, the position also being on the northerly 33.0' R/W line of
Peguaming Road.

(G2) Found the 1986 monument in good condition and at record bearing and distance from the 1986
W.Birch witnesses. Accepted same as a careful and faithful reestablishment of the position of the
corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

(MC) Set 1"IDx32" I.pipe with 4" alum. MDNR cap
for a WITNESS CORNER to the original M.C. which
is 114.37' south of the monument.
Set measuring nail with MDNR tag in the side of:
2" Tamarack N30E 49.59' mrkd "WC BT"
3" Tamarack S77E 62.39' do
Power Pole S25E 88.06'
Power Pole N33W 241.86'
Bearings are magnetic.

(G2) Fd. 5/8" dia. alum. post with BLM cap.
Set measuring nail with MDNR tag in the side of:
7" W.Birch S04E 37.7' mrkd "1/4S NBT" (1986 NBT)
10" W.Birch N82W 16.35' do do
7" twin Maple N26E 13.7' do
11" Maple S32W 46.75' do
Set sq'd Cedar post adjacent.
Bearings are magnetic.
