Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner: MC #12; East Meander Corner between B-1 and C-1, T52N, R33W; This corner was considered lost and reestablished on line at the proportionate distance between the N% corner of section 6 and the NE corner of section 6. This corner position falls in the Sturgeon River approximately 10 feet west of the right (east) bank of the river. A witness corner was established on the section line at a distance of 51.52 feet easterly of the proportioned meander corner. This witness corner is located approximately 40 feet east of the east bank of the Sturgeon River as presently located. C.
