I, DALE L. KESLER, in a field survey on October 20, 2000 do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and /or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

October 8, 1827, E.P. Hendricks, measured East from the 24th mile post 8.00 chains to lake and set post, witnesses:

14" W. Oak S 41 1/3 W 87 links

24" W. Oak N 70 W 157 links

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Did not find original meander post. Established meander corner from existing monumentation on the state line using a line between the Northwest Corner and Northeast Corner of Section 11, Township 38 North, Range 1 East, Indiana, and setting the meander corner on line and at the apparent high water mark.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

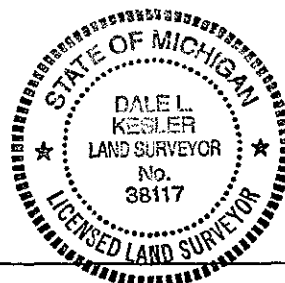
Set 3" x 36" concrete monument with brass cap and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.

Nail in 10" Oak S 73 deg 14' W 9.35'

Nail in 20" Maple S 14 deg 18' W 21.21'

Nail in 24" Oak S 27 deg 10' E 9.80'

Nail in 12" Oak N 76 deg 46' W 26.18'
