

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(F-3) 1/4 Corner Common to Sections 4 and 9, T.45 N., R.1 E.

Original corner post was placed in September, 1845 by James H. Mullett. 1919 County Surveyor notes call for post at 1/4 corner. In 1996, Ronald Bischer, P.S. 22428, found and used a 21/2" iron pipe approximately 6 feet West of a split between the Section corners to East and West and 1.75' North of a straight line between said Section corners.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(F-3) 1/4 Corner Common to Sections 4 and 9, T45 N., R.1 E. This corner is being re-established as part of the Chippewa County Remonumentation Program.

Found 21/2" iron pipe used in Bischer survey, on North margin of beaver flooding. Accepted corner position as found and established new witnesses.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

(F-3) 1/4 Corner Common to Sections 4 and 9, T.45 N., R.1 E.
