I, Keith R. Waters, in a field survey on April 11, 1997, do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

G-11 Corner common to Sections 27, 28, 33, & 34, T45N, R2W

1849 - Original corner (spruce post) was established by Harvey Mellen, D.S.

Witnesses: Spruce 9, N63°E 15 links - Cedar 12, S76°W 10 links

1908 - County Surveyor Frederick H. Brown notes for Section 28 state "Armstrong says Chamberlain located this corner probably for township road, culvert pipe and piece of tile for corner." A distance of 5300 feet is shown on the east side of Section 28, a distance of 5249 feet is shown on the south side.

Circa 1930's - Three separate entries in the Chippewa County Surveyor corner tie book show this corner with numerous ties to various fence corners, poles, and trees. Only one makes reference to the type of monument at the corner location, a 24" monument.

1959 - Ray Walker, Michigan State Highway Department, liber 2, page 235, Chippewa County corner records. Corner is a 1" iron bar. Witnesses: P. Pole, N81°E 76.00' - T. Pole, S37°E 39.04' - F. Post, S65°W 57.23'

1559 - Ray Walker, Michigan State Highway Department, liber 2, page 238, Chippewa County corner records. Found 1/2" iron pin. Witnesses: P. Pole, S45°E 38.82' - P. Pole, N45°E 31.43'

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

This corner is being perpetuated as part of the Chippewa County Remonumentation Program.

Found a 3/4" iron bar in an old wooden post at the intersection of 17 Mile Road and Johnson Road. Found no evidence of any of the previous witnesses as mentioned above. Distances to adjacent section corners check well with above mentioned 1908 County Surveyor notes. Accepted corner as found.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Found a 3/4" iron bar in an old wooden post at the corner location, which falls in the approximate centerline of an east-west gravel road (17 Mile Road), approximately 4 feet west of the centerline of a north-south road (Johnson Road).
Witnesses:

Power Pole (RU2-96-30), S47°E 45.96'

Power Pole (E-8), N67°E 73.28'

Power Pole (E-9), N78°W 181.26'

Telephone Pole, N60°E 39.46'

Note: Distances are to a nail/tag #33142 in the side of the pole.

Bearings are compass bearings corrected for declination.
