I, Keith R. Waters, in a field survey on November 10, 1997, do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and /or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

- A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:
 - L-9 1/4 Corner common to Sections 24 & 25, Town 45 North, Range 2 West
 - 1849 Original corner (spruce post) was established by Harvey Mellen, D.S. Witnesses: Spruce 5, N65°E 26 links Tamarack 6, S25°W 20 links

Circa 1920 - Chippewa County Surveyor Frederick H. Brown notes for Section 25 indicate "could not find any properties".

1974 - LCRC liber 1, page 129, Lawrence R. Feindt, RLS 21566. A sketch of Section 25 on the back said of the LCRC shows this corner midway on line between the found section corner K-9 and section corner M-9, which was

shows this corner midway on line between the found section corner K-9 and section corner M-9, which was mathematically placed at a single proportionate position between found ¼ corner M-10 and section corner M-7.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

This corner is being reestablished as part of the Chippewa County Remonumentation Program.

Found no evidence of any monument at the corner location. Reestablished corner location as described in above mentioned LCRC. This position has been used for numerous surveys in Section 25, but was never monumented.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Placed a ¾" x 48" rebar with a stamped aluminum Chippewa County Remonumentation cap at the corner location, which falls in a large swamp, approximately 550 feet north of railroad tracks.
