

I, Larry R. Rogers, P.S., in a field survey on December 8, 2000, do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and /or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3. 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

- A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:
 - (G-5) Section corner common to Sections 9, 10, 15 and 16, Township 47 North, Range 2 East. The original corner post was placed in 1845 by John Mullett. In 1919, County Surveyor F.H. Brown "found the old cross lines... and put in post". In 1981, W.L. Karr, PS 27450 found no evidence of corner position and re-established this corner position "using a combination of proration and local evidence" and filed a LCRC in Liber 5 at Page 10 of the Chippewa County Corner Records.
- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner: Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

 (G-5) Section corner common to Sections 9, 10, 15 and 16, Township 47 North, Range 2 East

 This corner is being perpetuated as part of the Chippewa County Remonumentation Program.

 Found 1/2" iron pin from Karr survey and recovered one witness. Accepted corner position as found and established three new witnesses. Distance to 1/4 Corner to South measures 20077 for 1/2 and 2007 for

E OVUMEN three new witnesses. Distance to 1/4 Corner to South measures 2677 feet (C.S. = 2705 feet).

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner: (G-5) Section corner common to Sections 9, 10, 15 and 16, Township 47 North, Range 2 East.

Corner is a 1/2" iron pin with P.S. cap number 16041 on the extension of electric fence to the South and 10 feet North of electric fence to West.
