Pipe is 0.8' south of straight line between 'A11' & 'C11'. All GLO & CSR wit's are gone. 1" iron pipe accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner. -Reference Pt - Based on McClung's notes & LCRC- his position is Easterly 25' +/- from 'B11'. Per discussion with land owner John Brooks, Mr. Brooks had moved McClung's 5/8" CIR out of Field and reset. We find McClung's CIR- N77°24'E 7.32' -down 1'- from 'B11' as pointed out by Mr. Brooks.
