Excavated 4'x4' hole 2.5' deep to natural ground and Found 2" Pipe 2.33 feet east of Township line and 0.5' deep Found PK Nail at surface 2.6' West and 2.0' South of 2" Pipe above. Found 1/2" Iron at M-4, Eagle, approximately North, 109.90'

The average of the G.L.O. closing distances at A-3 and A-5 is 111.54', the corner found seems to fit this distance, within reason, but is off the township line by 2.33'. The actual corner, properly established, should be according to the plat map prepared by the G.L.O. or equidistant between the closing corners A-3 and A-5. The true position is 3.91' south of the 2" pipe found near A-4 and on the Township line between M-4 and M-5 of Eagle Township. I accept the true position as a careful and faithful establishment of the position of the corner as corrected.
