Szyszkoski , in a field survey on <u>August 76, 1992</u>, 19 , do hereby certify that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law, established, re-established, monumented, re-monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 4 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

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A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(B3) Quarter corner common to Sections 6-7. Corner established by U.S. Deputy Surveyor John Burt, 1849. Original BTs: Codar 10 S47W 18. Remlock 14 F33E 10. Found no subsequent record.

(C1) Section corner common to Sections 5-6 7418-229% and Sections 31-32 7428-229%. Original corner established by U.S. Deputy Surveyor Wm. A. Burt, 1849. Original BTs: Hemlock 6 8058 58, F.Birch - BOBW 39. Found no subsequent record.

[4] Mitsess corner to the Borthwest 1/16 corner of Section 6, T41M-R29M. Corner not established in the original survey. Found no subsequent record.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(83) Original post and accessories not recovered. Determined corner to be lost and reestablished the corner by single proportionate measure to the original record between monumented corners 2583.79° east and 2696.84° west. About 60° west of the corner, found a probable Hamma Mining Co. monument, disturbed, at the base of a small ledge, from which it had fallen, and a blaze on a 20° poplar facing it. It appears that this mining co. monument was placed 2648° from the section corner to the east. A mining co. witness pipe was found adjacent to the poplar. Both the witness pipe and the brass capped monument were removed and placed next to the reestablished corner. Found a 5/8° iron pin w/brass tag 86307 wired on - apparently an old mining co. traverse station, \$088-27.6° from the corner.

(C1) Original post and accessories not recovered. Corner falls in old Groveland mine tailings pond. Found no other evidence on the ground. Reestablished the corner by single proportionate measurement to the original record between recorded section corners 5291.48° east and 5407.24° west.

(4) Found so evidence of previous monumentation. Established this witness corner on a straight line connecting 1/16 corners 93 and 95, 240.00° west of the northwest 1/16 corner of Section 6 (corner 94). Corner 93 is monumented. The positions of all other 1/16 corners were computed, their location determined by the current BLM instructions for the subdivision of regular sections.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

(83) Placed a 1°x30° iron pipe capped with a 4° dia. cast aluminum MONE tablet. Blazed and scribed the following new bearing trees:
7° T. Birch \$41V 11.6' (1/45 BBT)
19° V. Pine 864V 56.4' (1/45 BBT)
28° V. Pine B64V 10.0' (1/45 BBT)
Placed a sq'd ash post B05V, 1.7' from the corner.

(C1) Placed a 1"236" iron pipe capped with a 4" dia. cast aluminum MDB2 tablet from which bears four 1.75"x8' iron pipes, set approximately 3.5' in the ground as follows:

B15W 4.7', B79E 4.7',
S12E 4.8', S82W 4.7'.
The southeast toe of slope of the tailings pond embantment (course S55W) bears B35W, 194' distant.

[4] Placed a 1"x32" iron pipe capped with a 4" dia. cast aluminum MDHE tablet stamped "Witness Corner BW1/16 Sac. 6 240.00" Hast".

Blazed and scribed the following BTs: 5" W. Birch SOBE 15.2" (WC BT) 7" Maple S3BE 25.5" (WC BT) 5" W. Birch S7TE 63.5" ACT TO BIRCH STREET STR
