cap witnessed by 5" Spruce N30E 82 1/2 links (54.45'), 6" Balsam S15W 48 1/2 links

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(I04) Accepted found capped rebar and Four witnesses (two living and two others [SE
Balsam is a stub, SW Cedar is tipout]) and drove MDNR Monument over the top of existing
position. Position is accepted as a careful and faithful PERPETUATION of the position
of the original corner.

(J05) Accepted found MDNR Monument and remains of four existing NBT Witnesses
(standing dead). Position is accepted as a careful and faithful REESTABLISHMENT of the
position of the original corner.
