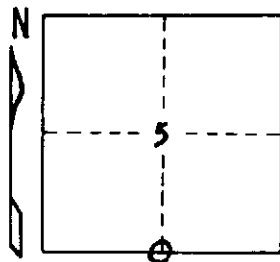

DESCRIPTION OF CORNER 1/4 corner between Sections 5 and 8

CORNER MONUMENT 1" I.D. x 36" iron pipe with 4" aluminum cap

DATE MONUMENT PLACED AND WITNESSED January 13, 1970

WITNESSES TO CORNER..... Sugar Maple 5 N36°W (mag.) 21 lks. "1/4S, NBT"



Sugar Maple 6 N66°E (mag.) 17½ lks. "1/4S, NBT"

AND

CIRCLE CORNER REGISTERED

DESCRIPTION IN DETAIL AS TO HOW CORNER WAS LOCATED AND IDENTIFIED OR RESTORED.

Found a 4" x 4" x 4' squared cedar post and an 8' steel fence post in place, apparently long used for local metes and bounds surveys. Monuments are neither equidistant distant from, nor on line between section corners to E and W (2638.7 ft. to E and 2652.9 ft. to W, with a @ 14' right deflection at the 1/4 corner when proceeding westerly on section line.) However, it was felt that moving the corner would create too much disturbance of local surveys, so it was perpetuated as found.

Corner accepted as found.
