I, Stephan J. Szyszkoski, in a field survey on _____, 19____ do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law, established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

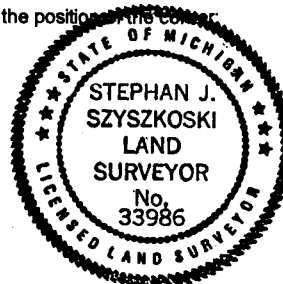
(B7) Quarter corner common to Sections 18-19. Corner established in 1850 by John Burt: "...40.00 Set sugar qr. Section post. Sugar 22 N47E 67, Sugar 20 S46W 5." A sketch titled "Copied from Map Sept. 1921 by J.E. Gingrass (Oct 12 1931 E. Nelson)" found on page 0059 of field book "Co. RD 12 Ralph-Alfred" at the Dickinson Co. Rd. Commission office in Iron Mtn, shows a distance of 2660' along what appears to be (but is not labelled as) a representation of the north 1/2 of the N-S 1/4 line of Section 19. Corner shown on a survey by R.Perkins, dated 11/10/78 "Old cedar post and iron pin, Maple 18" S30E 100.6", with a distance west to Sec. cor. of 2737.6'

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(B7) The original post and accessories were not recovered. Recovered the Center of Section 19 and the Quarter corner 19 & 30, both monumented by Dickinson Co., and using these, reestablished the position shown on the sketch noted above. I note that position falls about 12' east and 9' north of the subsequently reestablished position. Recovered a 3/4" rebar 2737.96' east of the SW corner of Sec. 18, probably that shown on Perkins' drawing, 40' east of the monumented position. This 3/4" rebar does not fit the measurements on the Rd. Commission sketch and is not in accord with the original record. Finding no specific reference to a monument in the Co. Rd. notes, it being an incomplete record, and finding no monument whose position is in agreement with these notes, I am reluctant to reestablish this corner in accord with them and so reestablish the corner on a line of mean true bearing between Section corner 2698.40' W'yly and Section corner 2645.49' E'yly, being proportionate to the original record. At the position for the corner, I place a 1" IDx32" iron pipe capped with a 4" dia. cast aluminum MDNR tablet, appropriately stamped.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of this corner:

(B7) Set 1" pipe with 4" MDNR cap.
Blazed and scribed the following:
15" Twin Sugar N31E 349.8' "1/4S NBT"
5" Spruce S77E 15.4' do
12" Sugar S42E 123.2' do (being
southwesterly Sugar in clump of 4)
12" Sugar S63W 225.7' "1/4S NBT"
Placed squared cedar post adjacent.
Bearings are magnetic. Distances are to
notch in lower blaze.
