A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(2-Sec.16) East 1/16 corner between Section 9-16. Corner not established in the original survey. Found no subsequent record.

(4-Sec.15) Northwest 1/16 corner, Section 15. Corner not established in the original survey. Found no subsequent record.

(8-Sec.15) Northeast 1/16 corner Section 15. Corner not established in the original survey. Found no subsequent record.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(2-Sec.16) Found no evidence of prior monumentation at the corner position. Established the corner on a straight line between Quarter corner 1317.25' West and Section corner 1317.25' East. At the position for the corner, I placed a 1" I.D.x32" iron pipe capped with a 4" dia. cast aluminum MDNR tablet, appropriately stamped.

(4-Sec.15) Found no evidence of prior monumentation at the corner position. Established the corner at the intersection of straight lines connecting opposite 1/16 corners, corners 81, 83, 85 being monumented, corner 88 a computed position midway between Center of Section and West 1/4 corner. At the position for the corner, I placed a 1" I.D.x32" iron pipe capped with a 4" dia. cast aluminum MDNR tablet, appropriately stamped.

(8-Sec.15) Found no evidence of prior monumentation at the corner position. Established the corner at the intersection of straight lines connecting opposite 1/16 corners, all monumented. At the position for the corner, I placed a 1" I.D.x32" iron pipe capped with a 4" dia. cast aluminum MDNR tablet, appropriately stamped.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

(2) Set 1" pipe with 4" MDNR cap.  
 Blazed and scribed the following bearing trees:

3" Sugar S32W 5.0' "1/16S BT"  
 4" Sugar N64W 2.9' "1/16S BT"  
 4" Sugar N24E 16.0' "1/16S BT"  
 3" Ironwood S54E 2.5' "1/16S BT"

Found a forester's squared post 26' N. and 3' W. and reset adjacent to monument. Bearings are magnetic.

(4) Set 1" pipe with 4" MDNR cap.  
 Blazed and scribed the following bearing trees:

4" Balsam Fir S41E 9.0' "1/16S BT"  
 12" Balsam Fir S40W 20.2' "1/16S BT"  
 3" Balsam Fir N10W 7.1' "1/16S BT"  
 5" Balsam Fir N50E 33.0' "1/16S BT"

Set a squared 2" Birch post adjacent. Bearings are magnetic.

(6) Set 1" pipe with 4" MDNR cap.  
 Blazed and scribed the following bearing trees:

6" Spruce S43E 33.9' "1/16S BT"  
 7" Spruce S17W 27.4' "1/16S BT"  
 9" Spruce S70W 40.1' "1/16S BT"  
 5" Aspen N00W 14.3' "1/16S BT"

Set a 3" squared balsam post adjacent. Bearings are magnetic.
