I, Stephen J. Szyszkoski, in a field survey on August 01, 1994, 19  
do hereby certify that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned  
in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the  
current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land  
Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5  
above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a  
Court of Law, established, re-established, monumented, re-monumented, recovered, found as  
expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 4 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded  
on this certificate.

## A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(K10) Quarter corner common to Sections 25-36. Corner recorded in 1954 by Dean C. DeLaMater, set by proportionate measurement. 1"  
pipe with 4" brass cap. Witnessed by 30" Boulder S34E 100 links. Found no subsequent record.

## B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(K10) Found the monument placed in 1953 by DeLaMater, a 1" I.D. iron pipe with 4" brass Michigan Dept. of Conservation tablet, in good  
condition, apparently undisturbed, 67' west of the centerline of a county road. The boulder witness was found S31E, 48.3' (to top)  
from the monument. I suspect that the boulder, being in a ditch, was moved since the 1954 recordation. Left the monument in place and  
marked 3 new witnesses as described below.

## C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

(K10) Found 1" pipe with 4" brass cap.  
Blazed and scribed the following new  
bearing trees:  
12" Spruce N64W 26.8' 1/4S NBT  
8" Spruce S61W 27.6' 1/4S NBT  
A wood fence corner post with fencing  
west bears S86E 96'  
The boulder noted in the 1954 record is  
S31E 48.3' to its top. Bearings are  
magnetic.
