- 7) Survey recorded in Liber 3 Page 83 by Ronnie Lester #18998 on January 31, 1980 notes "Set 1/2" bar & cap" with the following witnesses: Set nail & tag in SE side 36" Cottonwood NE 101.10'; Set nail & tag in SE side 36" Cottonwood NE 136.35'; Set nail & tag in West side 36" Cottonwood, ENE 112.00'
- 8) LCRC recorded in Liber 2 Page 785 by Ronnie Lester on February 17, 1982 notes "Original monument and accessories lost. Corner falls in tilled field.
